Community Service

We need folks to measure and select fabrics for backing, sew backing pieces together and iron them, and of course, layer with batting and package the kits. Join us for the whole time or just an hour or two. A microwave and fridge are available for "brown bagging" lunch or treat yourself to a Subway - in the plaza next door.

We were able to donate 45 dog beds and 26 cat mats to Manatee County Humane Society in May. Please remember that we cannot collect fabric and batt scraps anymore - we don't have anywhere to gather to assemble the dog beds. We ask that members take dog bed covers home, fill them with the acceptable scraps, close them, and return to a meeting. These donations help the guild maintain its 501c3 tax-exempt status.
