Library Page





One-Block Wonder Panel Quilts Class With Darlene Schwartz Saturday, June 8, 9:00-3:00 At Fair Lane Acres Clubhouse 810 49th Ave Terrace, Bradenton

Class Supply List

- Required text: <u>One-Block Wonder Panel Quilts</u> by <u>Maxine Rosenthal and Nancy</u> <u>Miller (available on Amazon)</u>
- 7 repeats of a fabric panel. DO NOT PRE-WASH THE FABRIC!!!! (Bits and Pieces in Bradenton has panels on sale and if you like one that isn't on sale there will be a discount for members taking the class.)
- Rotary Cutting tools mat, rotary cutter, rulers one long, one short, and one a 60 degree ruler
- Flower Pins. These pins lay flat; flat enough for a ruler to be over them and the ruler will still be flat against the fabric
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Wooden pressing tool or small iron
- Design wall (can be piece of flannel or batting, foam core covered with flannel or batting, or flannel backed table cloth)
