Hope you all had a great July 4th. Are you ready for our August 1 Community Service meeting?

Doors will open at 5:00; demos will begin about 5:15. We will be doing demos a bit differently than our usual round robin format. There will be "stations" for members to visit as they choose. The stations each show a part of how quilts may be completed. A team will be layering quilt tops on the stage; a few stations will show several ways to use simple designs to quilt the quilts that are to be donated, and we are hoping to have an area for spray basting the layers. We will have a "map" at the check-in showing where each station is located.

A few of the simple designs start with an "X" on the quilt top. We will have kits "X-ed" for members who wish to start sewing right away. There will also be kits available to take home. If you plan to bring your sewing machine and have reserved your spot, please remember to bring a good extension cord and anything else you will need (power cord, foot pedal, walking foot, sewing gloves, etc.). We will provide an ironing board and an iron.

At our July workshop, our amazing team layered all of the quilt tops that were in storage. Getting the quilts quilted, and bound for donation is the next step. Soon we will be asking for more quilt tops and quilts. Our donations help to keep the Guild a 501c3 tax exempt organization.

The Humane Society received seventeen dog beds in July. If possible, please wait until next month to bring any dog beds or cat mats – our "transportation space" we will not have the space this month.

Our regular business meeting will begin at 7:00. Show & Tell will be limited to 2 items – including UFO #8. For Show & Tell next month we will extend the items – stay tuned!!

Hope to see everyone Monday, August 1 - we will provide water and snacks and we hope to have fun surprises, too! Do not forget items for the church's food bank and back to school supplies for the children at Oneco Elementary.

Great Stash Buster



Supplies List

In addition to regular supplies, make sure you have a walking foot and a few safety pins. Bringing your machine manual along is not a bad idea. Some machines need the top pressure adjusted a little.

Fabric Requirements

7- 3.5" x 23.5" strips (red in illustration. These can be scrappy.)



- 8 2" x 23.5" sashing strips 2 - 2" x WOF sashing strips
- 4 4" x WOF outside border
- 4 -2.5" x WOF binding strips (or your favorite binding width)

1 yard backing fabric (I don't recommend piecing this)

36" x 45" batting

Payment for the class and the finished quilt will be donated to the to the Guild. Think Baby quilts when choosing fabrics.
