In this class you will learn about fabric choices, perspective, and using hues correctly to create a painterly and realistic image. The kit will supply fabrics that will all work beautifully, and you will get to choose which ones you want to use and how to lay them out. Then you'll learn to stitch elements such as trees, grasses, and flowers. They are simple to do with just two stitches, and will give your picture amazing details and life! You will leave with a wonderful picture (finished or nearly so), and a great foundation for making another landscape (or two or ten!) on your own.
