Community Service

Our next Community Service workshop will be on **Friday**, **March 11**, **9** a.m.-**3** p.m. at the South County Library, **6081 26th St W, Bradenton**. Join us for the whole time or just an hour or two.

Wow! We had a terrific Community Service workshop on February 11 - the "crew" (Mary, Deb, Dolores, Jody, Joyce, Judie, Judy, Sandi & June) layered 29 quilts. Thank you, ladies! These quilts will be available for members to take home, quilt, bind, & label and return at a regular meeting. We are including the labels, they are paper-backed cloth. Remove the paper backing & sew the cloth label to a corner of the quilt backing. Because the edges are pinked there is no need to turn the label under. The paper backing has the quilt's size so please include that in the plastic bag when returning the quilt.

The Humane Society received 42 dog beds & 37 cat mats on February 9. Thanks to everyone who used their scraps of fabric & batting to stuff the dog bed covers and sewed cat mats. A reminder - when stuffing the covers (available at the Community Service table at meetings), please be sure there are no pins or other "sharps", no yarn, no foam, no wool, no heavy knits & no buttons. Also remember that we cannot accept fabric scraps at this time.

Our donations of quilts, dog beds & cat mats help to maintain the guild's status as a 501c3 tax-exempt organization.


