# Community Service

#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

Our next Community Service workshop at South Manatee County Library will be held Monday, November 14, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. We will be putting quilt top kits together. There's a fridge and microwave available if you wish to bring lunch or you can order from Subway in the adjacent plaza.

Hurricane Ian caused a lot of damage and loss, especially south of here. Because we have such awesome, generous & talented members, we were able to donate 51 quilts to families in Myakka City. That leaves only a few finished quilts in storage; however, we have LOTS of ready-to-quilt tops - layered with batting and backing - waiting to be finished. Please take one or two home after our next meeting - they're available at the Community Service table. If you are planning to make a quilt to donate, please be sure it measures at least 40" x 40". Please also pickup labels and attach it to the quilts and use the backing from the labels to write the measurements of your quilt.

The Humane Society received 29 cat mats and 11 dog beds. They were also affected by Ian, as they housed some evacuated animals at their facility. We hope to provide more dog beds and cat mats next month, so please pick up some dog bed covers (and instructions for filling them) before or after our meeting at the Community Service table. All our donations help to maintain our status as a 501c3 tax-exempt organization.

The completed image will be 8" x 10" and will give you a foundation you can build on to create your own future landscape originals.
