At our workshop on September 12, the "crew" put together quilt top kits. We are taking a break from layering since we have a large inventory right now. We will be putting more kits together in November.

Now for impressive info - from October 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022, we have donated 375 dog beds and 355 cat mats to Manatee County Humane Society! Seventy-five quilts were also donated to The Least of These - a foster care agency. Guardian Ad Litem received thirty-five quilts and two twin quilts, and three baby quilts were given to His Girls Disciples.

Quilts have been donated to local folks - two people burned out of their home have received quilts, a USMC veteran who has lung cancer, another USMC veteran who helps in her community, and a woman who is having serious health issues. Quilted items were donated to Nora's auction and a quilt was donated to Tunnel to Towers. The local U.S. Women's Veterans scheduled a luncheon recently. Two quilts also were donated to their fund-raising auction all proceeds to benefit Honor Flight of West Central Florida.

So grateful to our members who have used their talent to bring comfort to our neighbors - and help to maintain our 501c3 taxexempt status. Continue the trend - take home kits to complete and dog bed covers to fill (along with instructions for filling).
