Food vendors are available at the Kid 'n' Ewe event. No meals will be provided by the contest. Only Texas residents may enter the TMIWW contest. When necessary, a driver's license or other legal documentation may be requested to verify state residency.

PRIZES

All contestants receive fabric from Texas MIWW and Pendleton Woolen Mills in Portland, Oregon.

Pre-Teen Winner receives a Serger given in memory of Lillian Wissemann.

Junior and Senior Winners Receive a stipend towards their trip to the National MIWW Competition in Denver, CO on January 21-24, 2021.

Adult Winner receives \$150 cash and submits an electronic entry to the National Contest. National finalists are eligible to attend the national competition.

There are additional prizes for second place and specialty awards. Best Construction is chosen from any of the divisions and receives an Ott Sewing light.

\$500 scholarship available to one 2020 contestant which will be attending college in the 2021-2022 school year; awarded by the Hill Country Sheep and Goat Organization and TSGRA.

Deadline for Sewing Competition Entries is October 15, 2020

Detach the entry form and mail with material samples:

- Two 5" x 5" samples of each wool fabric
- Two 36" long samples of each yarn
- \$12 entry fee for each entry in all divisions
- Testing is free for the first fabric or yarn for each entry.

Please include:

- \$8 for each additional material to be tested.

YOUR ENTRY IS NOT COMPLETE WITHOUT ALL INFORMATION, FABRIC SAMPLES AND ENTRY FEES. MIWW is not responsible for late, misdirected or lost entries.

- To be eligible, a garment must have been completed after January 1, 2020.
- Entry form may be copied as needed. Use a separate form for each entry.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

We recommend testing fabric before constructing your garment. Samples may be sent in for early testing with your contact information. Entry forms may be sent at a later date, prior to the entry deadline. See www.texasmakeitwithwool.com for some tips and tricks for fabric testing.
