The Invasive Cane Toad

Cane toads, also known as bufu or marine toads, are a large invasive species that are poisonous to most animals including domestic pets. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) encourages communities to have the toads removed and euthanized whenever possible. Community Field Services offers trapping services which includes disposal of toads, rebaiting and resetting the traps for communities in Southwest Florida.
