

BEGINNING SEWING CLASS DESCRIPTION

We offer 2 types of sewing classes:

- KIDS GROUP CLASS
- ADULT PRIVATE SESSIONS

KIDS GROUP CLASS:

1 session, 2 hours, Saturdays 10:00 – 12:00.

Min 2 students up to 4.

Project: Pillow Cushion

Cost: \$70.00 plus \$ 25.00 materials. Includes fabric, Thread, Buttons, Pillow insert (16"x16") Folder with instructions to repeat the project at home.

During this class, the students will learn:

- The parts of the machine, how to thread it and fill the bobbin.
- They will practice with the machine, sewing different types of stitches and stitch lengths.
- The students will design their project, laying out the pieces of fabric on their table.
- They will cut the pieces of their project on the fabric, learning how to trace the pattern.
- The students will pin their pieces together and they will start sewing their project.
- The students will have assistance to iron their pieces before and during the sewing process.
- As an accent, they will decorate the front of their project with hand sewn buttons (optional).

ADULT PRIVATE SESSIONS:

\$40.00 per hour, plus materials (depending on the project). This class can be booked Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, 10:00 - 11:30, 10:30 – 12:00, 11:00 - 12:30.

For Beginning Sewing adult private class, the students need to take 1 session, 1.5 hour as an introduction to learn how to use the machine (provided). The total cost of this class is \$60.00 plus \$ 10.00 materials.

During this class, the students will learn:

- The parts of the machine, how to thread it and fill the bobbin.
- They will practice with the machine, sewing different types of stitches and stitch lengths.

At the end of this first session, we will work with the projects suitable for the beginning level.

With these projects, the students will learn:

- How to design their item/garment laying out the pieces of fabric on their table.
- How to cut the pieces of their project on the fabric, learning how to trace the pattern.
- The students will pin their pieces together and they will start sewing their project: Front and back, folding edges, sewing in a straight line and lining projects if necessary.
- The students will have assistance to iron their pieces before and during the sewing process.
- Depending on the project and as a part of the finishing process, they will learn how to hand sew buttons, make buttonholes, sew zippers and attach hardware.
