

CHILDREN AND GRIEF COURSE

It is aimed at developing an understanding of the emotional impact of bereavement on children/young people, and identifying ways of supporting them in their grief. Depending on previous experience, additional training may be required.

- To gain and develop an understanding of issues that affect bereaved children and their families.
- To learn the skills of working with bereaved children, including neurodivergent children and young people.
- To develop awareness of children's needs in school and to promote education in bereavement.
- To acquire listening skills using play to facilitate grief work.
