

CAN WE GET TO YOU IN AN EMERGENCY?

Two important factors in providing emergency response to your home are proper address posting and clearance of roads and driveways. If we can't find you we can't get to you. If there is not adequate clearance of flammable vegetation along roads and driveways we may not be able get to you. Help responders by ensuring these two simple tasks are completed and maintained.



Posting your address will assist emergency responders in locating your home. It is recommended that a standard green 24"X6" sign with 4" reflective numbers attached to a metal stake be used. This sign can be seen in the daylight as well as night with the reflective numbers. When roads and driveways serve more than one home, place all home addresses at the beginning of the road or driveway. Then place a single address sign at each driveway to the home. Using arrows to indicate direction of the house will aid responders.

Clear roads and driveways so emergency resources can get in and you can get out. Clear all flammable vegetation for a distance of 10 feet from each side of the road or driveway. Remove tree branches and limbs 15 feet above the road or driveway. Maintain clearance at all times. This will not only provide a safe means for access for emergency responders but may provide a means of escape in an evacuation event.
