## **Requirements for the Intern Firefighter:**

- 18 years of age.
- Possession of high school diploma or GED.
- Valid California or county EMT-Basic certification, with current CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer & Healthcare Provider.
- Availability to volunteer for three (3) 24-hour shifts per month, and able to attend Wednesday-night training sessions.
- Possess adequate physical fitness in order to fulfill the physically-demanding (and potentially hazardous) tasks that a firefighter would perform.

## **Application process:**

- Applications are available for print online at <u>www.penrynfire.ca.gov</u>, accepted year-round.
- A written and physical agility test will be held year-round as staffing needs require, with successful candidates moving forward to interviews.
