# LeMoyne Industrial Park Emergency Procedures

## If you hear the SIRENS:

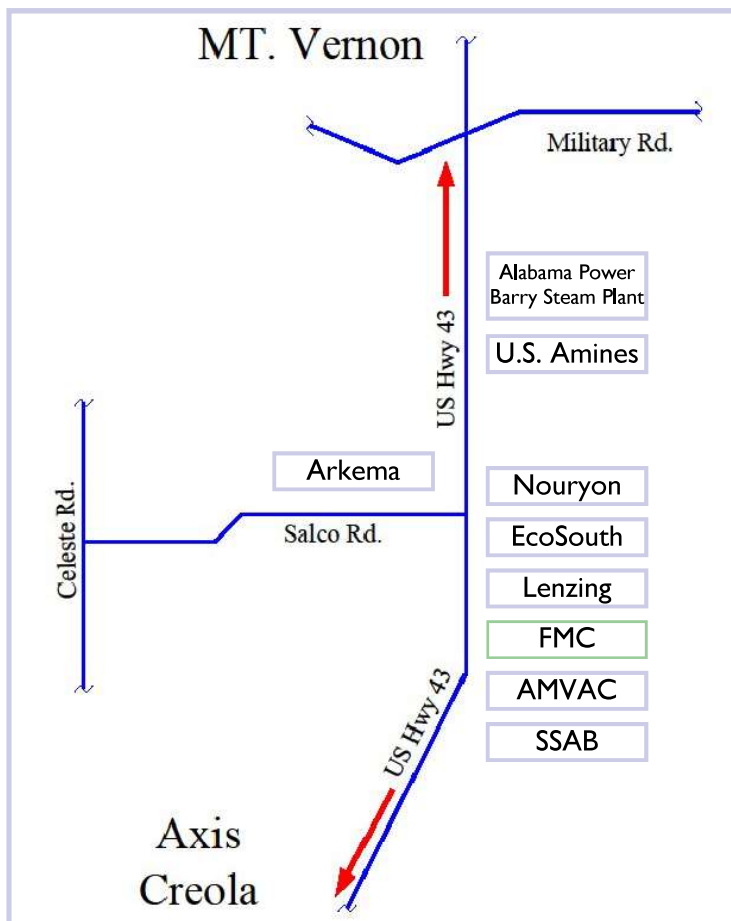
- If you hear a long steady siren— DON'T PANIC. Check it out. It could be a test.
- Siren tests are conducted every Wed. at 9 am.
- If you are unsure— ASSUME IT'S REAL! TUNE IN TO ANY LOCAL RADIO or TV STATION FOR INFORMATION.
- A real warning could mean fire, tornado, chemical spill, or any other emergencies.
- Listen carefully for information and what action, if any, to take.

## If advised of a tornado:

- Go at once to a windowless, interior room, basement or lowest level of your home or building. (Stay tuned to local radio or TV)
- If outdoors, go to a low-lying area or ditch.
- Do not delay to care for pets or gather personal belongings.
- If in a vehicle, immediately take shelter in a building. If there is no time, get out of the car and lie in a ditch or low-lying area away from the car. Be aware of potential flooding.

## If advised to shelter in place:

- Local officials may advise you to shelter in place via radio, TV, or incoming phone messaging. If this is the case, follow the given suggestions below.
- Go indoors immediately and close all doors and windows as tightly as possible.
- Account for all family members and neighbors, especially the elderly. Take pets inside. Don't stay outside to look for pets.
- Shut off all systems which draw air into the house (furnace, air conditioner, kitchen and bathroom vent fans,, fireplace dampers, etc.)
