

Plant Barry, Bucks Alabama

- Plant Barry began commercial operation in 1954 with Units 1 & 2 then continued to rapidly expand until 1971 with 3 additional coal fueled units increasing the total capacity to 1716 MWs (megawatts).
- Barry Unit 3 was decommissioned in 2015 and the fuel source on Units 1, 2, and 4 has since transitioned from coal to natural gas.
- Barry Units 6 and 7 are natural gas fueled units completed in 2000 adding another 1050 MWs.
- Construction of Barry 8 will be complete in the summer of 2023 and commercial operation should begin in October. It will supply another 723 MWs fueled by natural gas.
- Plant Barry will become the largest electrical generating site in Alabama after Unit 8 comes online and will be capable of producing 3107 MWs or enough power to supply approximately 500,000 homes.



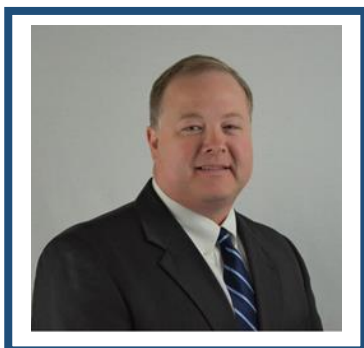
