WELCOME!

The LeMoyne Industrial Park was formed in 1983 by Courtaulds North America, Stauffer Chemical Company, Shell Chemical Company, Virginia Chemicals, M&T Chemicals, Alabama Power Company and the Alabama Property Company. The Industrial Park was formed under the provisions of Act 604 of the Alabama Legislature, which was enacted into law in 1978. The purpose of the park is to allow the members to cooperate on projects of common interest and restrict the property within the park to the uses described in the act, which includes manufacturing, assembling of products, treatment and processing of raw materials, and all of the support processes of these activities.

Other activities are allowed by the Act, but it does not make the members of the park responsible for the provision of services that would normally be provided by the city or county government; for example, police or garbage service. The park also provides a forum in which the members can plan and provide mutual aid to each other during emergencies and cooperate on safety and emergency response training. Our mission statement:

"To promote community improvement through mutual awareness, understanding, and appreciation between the community and industry."

We strive to be a good neighbor and the health and safety of our local community is important to us. Together with the Mobile County Emergency Management Agency, we have prepared an emergency plan for all those who live around the park (see pages 2-3). We helped to establish and continue to provide support to the LeMoyne Emergency Medical Services, which is now the Turnerville Volunteer Fire Department, Station 3. Finally, we have established an emergency alert siren system. Together with local radio and TV stations, this system gives important warning and information to area residents in the event of an emergency.
