After graduating from the University of Liverpool in 1986 he joined the British Company, Courtaulds. Ian worked in the Research & Development department and was part of the team that developed the technology to manufacture the TENCEL™ lyocell fibers that are produced here in Axis.

lan worked on the design and operation of several trial plants, to scale up the new

technology. It was during one of these projects, in Grimsby, England, that he met Louise, his wife of 33 years. Louise was the restaurant manager of the hotel where he lived for a year. Apparently the way to lan's heart really is through his stomach.

Courtaulds decided to build the first full scale commercial TENCEL™ production facility in Axis and that is what brought lan & Louise here for the first time, on a cold January day in 1992.
