In 1Q of 2018 AkzoNobel became Nouryon. Although the name of the company has significantly changed, the purpose and values of the company have stayed the same.

Nouryon's LeMoyne plant is located in Axis, AL

on Highway 43, approximately 20 miles outside of Mobile's city limits. The plant encompasses 650 acres stretching from highway 43 to the Mobile River. Continuously operating since 1953, the LeMoyne site consist of a Carbon Disulfide Plant, Sulfur Dichloride/ Sulfur Monochloride Plant, Sulfuric Acid Plant, Crystex© insoluble sulfur facility, Monochloroacetic Acid and Sodium Hydrosulfide unit. There are approximately 120 employees at the LeMoyne Site which help us produce more than 350,000 short tons of industrial chemicals annually. This production equates to approximately 10,000 shipments annually by rail, tank truck, drum, and bulk tank.

Nouryon is committed to the highest levels of performance in health, safety, and environmental protection. Nouryon follows the guiding principles of the Responsible Care Initiative. In July 2019, the LeMoyne Site surpassed 2 years without a Loss Time/ Recordable Incident.

Each year our employees are active in the surrounding communities and participate in and request sponsorships for area boosters, archery, cheerleading, dance teams, soccer, reading programs, football, baseball, softball, St. Jude Children's Hospital and the homeless.

The LeMoyne Site is active in the LeMoyne Community Advisory Panel, we provide support to the Turnerville Volunteer Fire Department, participate in Partners for Environmental Progress, and are a sponsor of the LeMoyne Industrial Park Community Day at the Creola Municipal Park each year.

Based in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, we serve our customers throughout the world with a renewed focus on coatings and specialty chemicals. But for us a LeMoyne our focus is the Mobile County area.
