




The InStep Vision Model: Lesson One

- Stated: Every Soul a Saint, Every Saint a Fellow, Every Fellow a Learner, and Every Learner a Ministry.
- Salvation (yellow block) is the foundation for all growth in Christ.
- The <u>WHY</u> of Salvation, and the <u>HOW</u> of Salvation. (John 3:16, Romans 10:9)







To Know We Are In Christ: Lesson Two







New Commandments of Love: Lesson Three







A New Lifestyle In Christ: Lesson Four







Winning Souls And Discipling Believers Lesson Five
