Dear Faith Family,

The past 4 days I've been blessed to begin the certification process as a Coach to Pastors and Leaders. 6 Presbyterian pastors and 9 Methodists were invited to attend.

Each morning I walked the beach for at least 45 minutes and watched the sunrise daily. Here are some spiritual reflections I've made:

The Pull of the sand...my feet were firmly planted when the sand was closer to the water.

Observations lead to new perspectives and possibilities. What are you observing about your life and the call of Jesus? Your gifts matter at any age and any place you find yourself.
