What is Stewardship?

Financial Stewardship is an important component of a balanced spiritual life. Returning to God from that which God has given to us is a tangible way to express our faith. Membership in a body of faith presupposes an inner spiritual hunger to return to God's church time, talents and treasures.

Per Capita is defined as an apportionment given to the Presbytery to support the Presbytery's budget, Synod's budget and General Assembly. Per Capita, is not defined as membership.

Membership in the Presbyterian Church USA is centered around active worship life. Worship is central to membership. "An Active Member participates in the church's work and worship."

What is a Stewardship Pledge?

Each year members of Winfield First Presbyterian Church are asked to make a stewardship pledge for the upcoming calendar year. A pledge is a one-year financial commitment to support the ministry within our congregation, to the Winfield community and to the world. Pledges made in connection with the current stewardship drive are paid during the calendar year, January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.

What is an Appropriate Pledge Amount?

We have included the above giving percentage chart as a guideline for those who would like to move toward this goal. The giving chart above shows amounts in dollars per month. All pledge contributions, regardless of the amount, are gratefully received as an expression of a member's commitment.
