I became friends with many of the musicians and even shared my work with them. It was Central Park at its heart that I was capturing as that place has healing powers that helped me find my way. 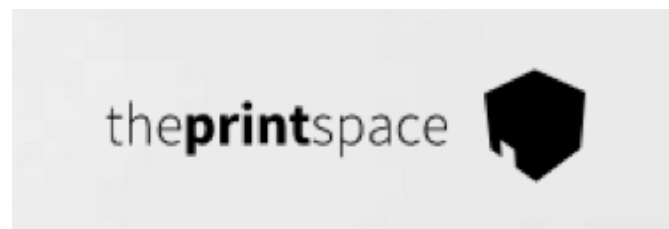

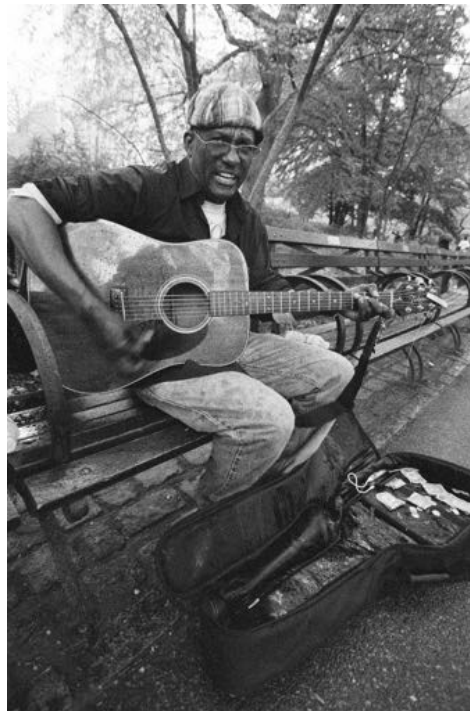

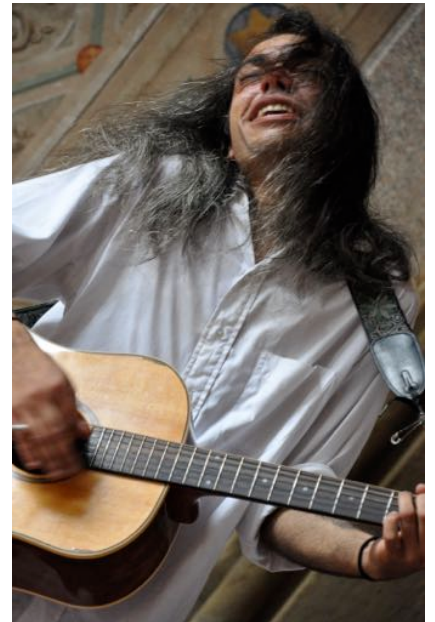
