ELIOT SEWER AND STORMWATER PROJECT – PORTLAND, OREGON

OVERVIEW:

The project upsized, repaired or replaced approximately 10,000 feet of deteriorating public sewer pipes that are 100 to 120 years old. The green street planters built as part of this project will divert 1.9 million gallons of stormwater annually from the sewer system. Separating stormwater from sewer pipes reduces the risk of street flooding, basement sewer backups into homes and businesses, and overflows into our rivers during periods of heavy rain.
