GREENFIELD ACRES DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS – FORT WORTH, TEXAS

OVERVIEW:

An underground storm drain system will be constructed on Cindy Lane, from Ten Mile Bridge to North Ridge Road, and on East North Hill Lane. The existing storm drain on the west end of South Ridge Road will be upsized and a new storm drain with two detention ponds will be constructed on the east end of South Ridge Road. A water line will be installed on Cindy Lane, and the existing sanitary sewer line will be replaced along Cindy Lane and South Ridge Road. After construction is complete, Cindy Lane will be repaved.
