HUNTINGTON BEACH TRASH REMOVAL PROJECT, PHASE 1- HUNTINGTON BEACH, CALIFORNIA

OVERVIEW:

The project proposes the installation of a trash removal device at McCallen Park, located under the existing parking lot. The proposed continuous deflection separator (CDS) unit will intercept trash from a 93" storm drain mainline that runs along Delaware Street. This storm drain conveys storm flows and urban runoff from a 382 acre watershed.

BENEFITS:

- Will deflect and intercept trash from a watershed.
- Holds stormwater.
- Irrigation for the trees is provided by pop-up sprinklers.
