PARKROSE STORMWATER PROJECTS – PORTLAND, OREGON

OVERVIEW:

Construction of a stormwater management project in a portion of the Parkrose neighborhood. This project is part of a larger effort to improve water quality in the Columbia Slough. To clean and filter stormwater in the area before it flows into the Slough, this project will construct 10 underground injection control structures, 12 manholes with manufactured stormwater treatment systems, 22 sedimentation manholes, and two green streets.





BENEFITS:

- These new structures will improve water quality, help control stormwater runoff during heavy rain events, and protect the Columbia Slough.
