SAFE CLEAN WATER PROGRAM (MEASURE W) – LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA

HISTORY:

Measure W was successfully passed by voters in November 2018 creating the Safe, Clean Water Program which will provide local, dedicated funding for stormwater and urban runoff to increase our local water supply, improve water quality, and protect public health.

ABOUT:

The Safe, Clean Water Program generates up to \$285 million per year from a special parcel tax of 2.5 cents per square foot of impermeable surface area on private property in the LA County Flood Control District. Publicly-owned parcels, including schools, are exempt under state law. Property owners who have installed stormwater-capture improvements can qualify for a tax credit. Qualifying low-income seniors and non-profit organizations are eligible for exemption. Revenues from the Safe, Clean Water Program are generated from a special parcel tax on private properties in the LA County Flood Control District.
