## VENICE HIGH SCHOOL– VENICE, CALIFORNIA

### OVERVIEW:

A new underground storm drain system will be constructed to alleviate campus flooding. A large underground detention facility will be constructed under the football field to store storm water runoff.




### BENEFITS:

- Improves flood management
- Will provide Enhanced habitat through the addition of California native trees and plants increase ecological function
- The existing exterior asphalt pavement will be replaced with natural color concrete paving, which will reduce heat
- Trees are added to increase shade.

### FUNDING SOURCES:

- Safe Clean Water Program aka Measure W
- District General Obligation Bonds is funding the design costs and the majority of the comprehensive modernization project.
