## VIEWRIDGE ROAD STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT- TOPANGA, CA

### OVERVIEW:

This Project will treat urban runoff and stormwater runoff by means of bio-filtration, improving water quality discharge into Topanga Creek and Santa Monica Bay.





### BENEFITS:

- Bio-filtration improves water quality discharge into the Topanga Creek, enhancing the beneficial uses of the habitat.
- Improves local streams and oceans by capturing and treating stormwater and urban runoff by filtering trash, metals, sediment, and other pollutants.
- Reduces stream flow velocity, helping manage floods. Adds community enhancement by promoting sustainable urban greening through the replacement of paved areas with new trees, drought tolerant landscaping, and drip irrigation.
- Will create more shade.
- Will provide education: the public interest on water resource challenges continues to grow, but awareness of innovative and nature-based solutions is still needed.
- Irrigation for the trees is provided by pop-up sprinklers.
