breakthrough, deliverance, and divine intervention.)

He’s not taking His time. He is right on time.
Paul and Silas in Prison (Acts 16:25-26)

- *“About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly, there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone’s chains came loose.”*



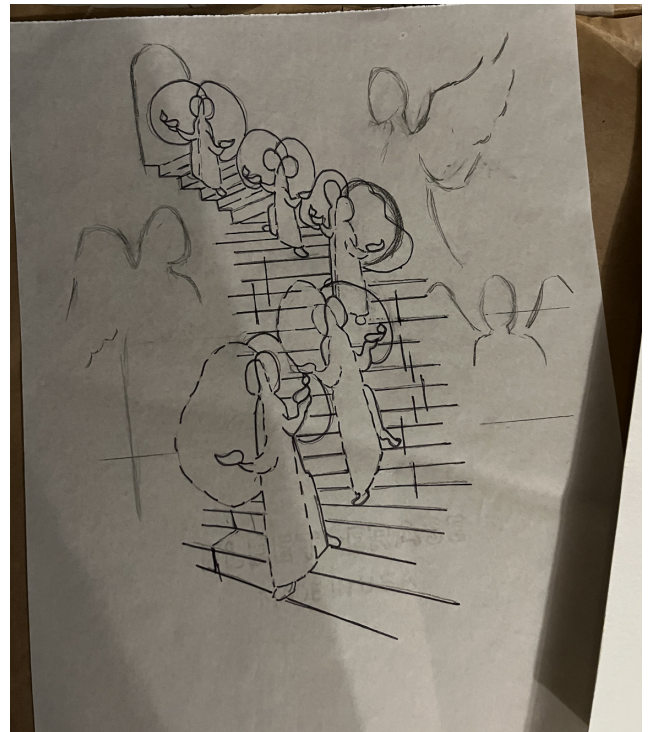
- **Meaning:** Midnight symbolizes a moment of **sudden breakthrough, freedom, and divine power**. Even in the darkest hour, worship and faith can lead to deliverance.

The Deliverance of Israel from Egypt (Exodus 11:4, 12:29)

- “Moses said, ‘This is what the LORD says: About midnight I will go throughout Egypt. Every firstborn son in Egypt will die...’” (Exodus 11:4)
- “At midnight the LORD struck down all the firstborn in Egypt...” (Exodus 12:29)
- **Meaning:** Midnight signifies **judgment on the enemy and breakthrough for God’s people**. It was the turning point when Israel was set free after years of slavery.

The Parable of the Ten Virgins (Matthew 25:6) (Sketch for Night of)

- “At midnight the cry rang out: ‘Here’s the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!’”
- **Meaning:** Midnight represents the **unexpected arrival of Christ, a time of readiness or reckoning**. It teaches about being spiritually prepared for God’s move.
- **A turning point:** When things seem darkest, God moves.
- **Breakthrough and deliverance:** God intervenes on behalf of His people.
- **Judgment and justice:** Midnight can represent the time when God’s justice is executed.
- **A call to spiritual readiness:** Being prepared for God’s next move.



Personal Application

If you’re facing a tough situation, the “midnight hour” can be a sign that a breakthrough is near.

Worship, prayer, and faith—like Paul and Silas—can usher in God’s power. So Trim the wick.

Stay spiritually prepared for God's timing, just as the wise virgins were ready for the bridegroom.

Wake up. Wake up. Wake up, all your sleepers.
