Exercise 10

Exercise 13

The left hand plays a sequence of notes: C3, D3, E3, F3, G3, A3, B3, C4, B3, A3, G3, F3, E3, D3, C3. Fingerings for the right hand are: 1 2 3 1, 2 3 4 5, 4 3 2 1, 3 2 1. Fingerings for the left hand are: 1 2 3 1, 2 3 4 5, 4 3 2 1, 3 2 1.
