THE BIG CHALLENGE – PART 1 Play all 12 chords with your left hand,

THE BIG CHALLENGE – PART 2 Play all 12 chords with your right hand.

THE BIG **BIG** CHALLENGE - Play all 12 chords with both hands together.

THE BIGGEST CHALLENGE: Play the chords with two hands together, and with your eyes closed!

Always keep mind:

1. The name of the chord you are playing (e.g. "C Major, C# Major, etc.).
2. Which notes are contained in the chord. (e.g. C Major – C, E, G)
3. The quality of the chord (major).
