### RODEO RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Contestant age determined as of Jan 1st, 2025
- 2. All NCJRA rules will be followed. You are responsible for knowing the rules. Rule Books are available.
- 3. All Contestants must wear Western Hat, Western Boots, Pants and Long Sleeved Collared Shirt. Shirts must be tucked in.
- 4. Any Contestant using drugs or alcohol on these grounds will be disqualified. No foul language allowed.
- 5. Contestant Back Numbers must be worn at all times while competing.
- 6. No one is allowed in the Arena or Behind the Chutes except Contestants competing in that event & 1 parent.
- 7. Any questions or concerns MUST be addressed to the Event Director first.
- 8. No Refunds will be issued without notice to the Rodeo Secretary **PRIOR** to the start of the Rodeo. Vet/Med Certificate required.
- 9. Entries must be postmarked by June 19th
- 10. Awards:50% Payback, Buckles to all First Place Winners in each event. All-Around Buckles and awards to High Point Boy & Girl. Points to be awarded using NCJRA Point System. All ties will be broken first with total money won, if money won is equal, then a coin flip will be done. The kid with the second highest money won or loser of coin flip will be the reserve winner.
- 12. <u>Entrance:</u> The Mounted Patrol will allow <u>two</u> family members in per Contestant. All others be prepared to pay a gate charge. Remember Norcal is not in charge of the gate.
