

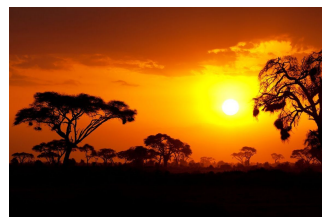


Was your Christmas full of the wonder of the Christ child?
