Kenya moved fast to shut down all their schools and training centres with the first victim, a lady who came home to Kenya from London where she worked. Twelve staff stay day and night until the lockdown is lifted. Three hand washing stations are in place.

During the "lockdown" from the Corona Virus, the children have been involved in prayer & devotions twice a day.

Three Grade 12 graduates teach the younger children in the morning. There's planting, watering, weeding in the garden plus time to play until suppertime, then under mosquito nets for sleep by 8PM.

Kenya plans to resume schools on June 4, 2020.

The manager asked for 4 months food mid March so we sent \$5,000 some of which came out of college student's accounts (and will have to be replaced.)



Funds for May 2020 are now due. We need to add \$2,250 because two year old bedding, slept on every night and washed once on Saturdays is worn out. To replace 30 mattresses (some are in pieces), 45 sets of sheets, 40 blankets, and 45 jackets we need your help.

Perhaps you would consider paying for a set of new sheets or a a jacket for \$10, a mattress for \$30 or a blanket for \$13. The used clothing markets have been stopped so we have to buy new.
