We are going to have a fun, professional and unique photography experience. There is no pressure to come into a session knowing what to do. I will guide you through each pose and coach you through getting candid images as well. If there is a pose you want to try or maybe a special location that has meaning for you. I'm happy to incorporate your ideas!

Art Booking

If you haven't already send me an email or give me a call so we can look at our calendars and pick out a date together. We have some flexibility that allows us to work around busy schedules. We will do our best to find a time slot that works for everyone.

Once we set a date we are going to decide how long of a session you want to book.

We have several options on our pricing page, and I can help you pick the package that would work best for you and fit in your budget. Lastly, we are going to chat about locations, I have recommendations of course but I want to hear about what you are looking for; Do you have a favorite spot? Enjoy going to the beach or maybe something more ethereal like a tall grassy field? Once I get to know you a little, we will figure out what the best spot will be and when the light will be best at that location.

If you don't have anywhere in mind that's ok too, you can just leave it up to me. Payments are made the day of your session via cash, check, credit, PayPal, or Venmo.



Hair & Makeup

Want to add a layer of experience to your session with a little pampering We would meet 2 hours prior to the session time. You can chat with your HMUA about the colors in your session wardrobe, and the look that you want to go for. Our stylists will make sure you look amazing before we start our session. If you don't typically wear makeup but still like the idea of this experience. Our stylists can do anything from a subtle look to all the glam you want! Bonus, way less stress on the day of your session. Just come in with a clean, moisturized face and your good to go. We will take care of the rest.

Say yes to props!

Should you bring props?

Absolutely!

Props can be anything that tell a part of your story. Things like sports equipment, musical instruments, hats, a graduation cap, a cute purse etc. are always welcome. Even a best friend, a pet, or your car. All of these can be considered props and are excellent to use in photos.

Each prop is personal to you and that is what is going to make your photos unique.

So if you are a summer loving ice cream fanatic, or a huge Star Wars fan. Great!

Let's showcase that in a few images! Styling with jewelry, jackets and accessories can also make a photo pop. If you're not sure if you should bring something feel free to ask.

But as a general rule I say bring it and if we don't end up using it that's ok too.

As an FYI props "usually" are NOT allowed in the yearbook but they are excellent ways to add different looks to your gallery, senior albums and make fun memories to look back on later. (haha ask me to show you mine!)



Bring the family



One of our most popular packages is the 90 min family/senior session.

What a perfect way to capture this milestone.

By making it a family affair. Because before you know it college visits, holidays and jobs start to take over.

We take the first 30 mins of the session for family photos with a mix of poses from the whole family, to sibling pictures, sometimes we even include the family pet.

The rest of the session is dedicated to your senior photos.



WHAT CAN YOU

Wear?





Deciding what to wear? Possibly the hardest part of the session.

You want to be comfortable, and feel like yourself.

We recommend bringing a minimum of 3 outfits to whatever session length you have chosen. Just so you have some options. Have you ever packed for a trip and then felt like you didn't want to wear what you packed or you just were not feeling it that day? This is why you bring options. Even if that means simply throwing a sweater or jean jacket on over a piece you're already wearing because that can easily change look and give you more variety in your gallery.

And if we have time why not? The clothing limits I have in packages are more for time restrictions but anything that we can fit in your time slot I'm game. Don't forget accessories are also a great idea earrings, boots, hats.

Our top recommendations - But make it you.

A casual dress look (Like something you would wear to a wedding, graduation etc.)

An everyday look (The things you wear to school everyday)

A hobby look (sports, dance, music, animals, vehicles etc.)

A few things that we do not recommend for photos:

fluorescent colors (exceptions for sports attire)

wrinkled clothing

Ill fitted clothing (too short or too tight)

During YOUR SHOOT

We will meet at the location you have chosen for your session; together we will look through your outfit selections and decide which outfits will be worn at what locations. We will talk about posing and where the light will look best to get started. I will help you pose and tell you where to place your hands. So, you don't have to worry. I will guide you through the whole experience.

Different poses add variety to your gallery and some poses look better in camera than they may feel in person. It's a "trust the process" type of thing. I know that poses can feel a little awkward or weird because it's just not the way you would normally stand or sit but for photos they work. However that said if you feel uncomfortable at any time just let me know and we can change things up. We want you to relax, feel confident and be yourself. Your personality will make your photos stand out. So don't be afraid to speak up, I am happy to try to incorporate any of your personal ideas. I will make sure you get some amazing images to show off! Want to make a tiktok during your session or do some behind the scenes shots? Let's do it!

After

YOUR SHOOT

We hope you had a great time, Seniors are one of our favorite types of sessions to photograph. We love helping you kickstart your senior year with some fun. We worked hard and you had an amazing session, But what do we do now?

1. Wait for your proof gallery: I am going to take these images back to my computer and go through every image we did picking out the best images to send you. I will make small adjustments to lighting, cropping, colors etc. Once I have gone through all of the images I create an online gallery for you and send the link to your email with next steps. These images are called "Proofs" they are high resolution and perfect for printing if you do not want/need any edits.

2. Select your favorites for final editing and yearbook: I am going to ask you to go through your proofs and "heart" your favorites the amount allowed will depend on which package you chose. Once you have made your final selections and chosen your yearbook. You will email me to let me know that your favorites have been selected and I can begin the editing process. But what exactly is an "Edit"? This is the process where I go in and I clean up any acne, even out skin tone or redness, take away stray hairs, fine tune colors, brightness and even take away things from the background that may be distracting like people on a beach or trail signs. Once your edits are complete, I will add those images to the Edit folder in your online gallery. You will then have access to both your proof and edit folder.

3. Ordering Prints: You can order prints directly from our lab through the online gallery and have them shipped to you or you can download as you please. We are also happy to help you place an order if needed. We understand that not everyone is tech savvy or may simply not have the equipment to download such large files. Please reach out if needed for us to help you. If you are looking to order one of our hand designed albums you can send me a message or give me a call and we can go over those options together.



F.A.Q

What forms of payment do you take?

Cash, Check, Venmo, PayPal, Credit Cards, we even barter on occasion!

Do I have to come back for an ordering session? How do I order prints or an album?

No, there is no requirement to come in and place an order. Our print lab is attached to your gallery, so you are welcome to order from the comfort of your home and have your prints shipped directly to you or a loved one. If you feel more comfortable coming in to place your order I am happy to do that for you as well.

Can I download?

Yes, you can download your images and take them to be printed at a lab of your choosing. You can also order a USB drive if that is easier for you.

How do I order an album?

Because I design the albums myself those cannot be ordered through the website. These get ordered directly through me so we can chat about the design. Just send me a email or give me a call to discuss.

How do I get the picture to the school for yearbook?

We take care of that for you, once you have made your selection for final editing you will also let me know which of those you would like for the yearbook.

I take care of editing, sizing, labeling, and sending the image to the school.

I will send you a email for approval before it goes to the school.

(We will CC you on the email, but we do recommend a follow up with them to make sure it was received and didn't end up in spam). We are familiar with most of the schools requirements but feel free to forward them on to us as well.

I dont know any good locations, how does that work?

There are so many great options, Im happy to help make some suggestions based on your likes and lighting in those locations. We can do this during your consultation.

Can you come to my house?

Yes, We can do your session anywhere you would like. If you want to do them inside at your house, Just let me know so we can bring the appropriate equipment.

Can I have more than 1 session in different seasons?

Yes, you can book 2 separate appointments. Or we recommend booking the 2 hour session so there are no additional fees.

What if there is bad weather? In the event of bad weather, We would reschedule.

Bad weather can be a variety of things when it comes to photos such as rain, wind, or extreme heat. I try my best to not have to reschedule as I value your time and know sometimes it can be tricky with sports and work. However, If you or I feel it will interfere with the quality of your experience then it is what it is. I watch the weather and try not to make a call too early because its Wisconsin and she changes her mind rather frequently. So, its usually a day of call. If you are preparing to get hair or makeup done with me or somewhere else then we can make that call a bit earlier. Just stay in contact with me and we will figure it out. No need to panic I promise! We will get them done, they will be turned in on time we got this.

I wear glasses, Will that effect my photos?

Usually No, however if you have a concern you can see if your eye doctor has a pair of frames without lens you could borrow. Or you can have them take out the lens on yours. Then have them put back in after your session. Its kind of like movie magic, if you have a spare pair, just bring those along so you can see while walking. Otherwise I will help be your guide.

Should I get a new haircut?

You definitely want to look your best, but we recommend if you're going to get your hair cut or colored that it be at least a week before your session. In case of any mishaps.

What if I am light sensitive?

Light sensitivity is a common problem, those with bright blue eyes, squinty or blinky eyes. If you know this is you just let me know so we can schedule your session later in the day and in a shaded location.

Can I bring someone with me?

Of course. Bring a friend, boyfriend/girlfriend, or the whole family! Its up to you.

When will I get my proofs back?

Our turnaround time during our busy season is approximately one/two weeks. We send you a gallery link via your email with a pass key to view your proofs. Along with details about how to save your favorites for editing.

Can you remove acne?

Yes, absolutely. This is part of our final editing process. We take care of shine, acne, fly away hairs, and other background distractions.

What is a proof vs. a final edit?

A proof is basic editing, cropping, color adjustments etc.

Whereas your final edits will be cleared of any distracting things in the background, stray hairs, acne etc. Your proofs are high resolution and ready to download if you don't need any edits, your welcome to download every single one of those images if you want.

Is there a time frame I have to select my images by?

Technically No, I do not have a time frame in which you need to get back to me about your edits, However know that as we get closer to yearbook deadlines more and more and more people are turning in their requests and a line starts. I do all yearbook images as they are turned in so that they meet school deadlines, and then your images return to their place in line on a first come first serve basis.



What are edits?

What is a soft edit or proof vs. a final edit?

A soft edit is basic editing, cropping, color adjustments etc. Whereas your final edits will be cleared of any distracting things in the background, stray hairs, acne etc. Your proofs are high resolution download ready images if you don't need/want any edits your welcome to download every single one of those images if you want.
