

This sense of pressure and expectation is well recognised by the FIRL squad and coaching staff who have been working hard behind the scenes to prepare for these upcoming fixtures.


On a positive note, should Italy qualify for the 2021 tournament, this would be their third consecutive World Cup appearance which would solidify their strong standing within the international rugby league community.
