Some members are happy to shake some are still not keen. Covid is still around along with other bugs in the community. So, we offer the following as a solution to this problem.


"At the end of the game if you wish not to shake hands just simply put your hand up and say thanks for the game." Your opposition will now know not to offer their hand to shake.


#### Committee member resigns


