The British GC Doubles

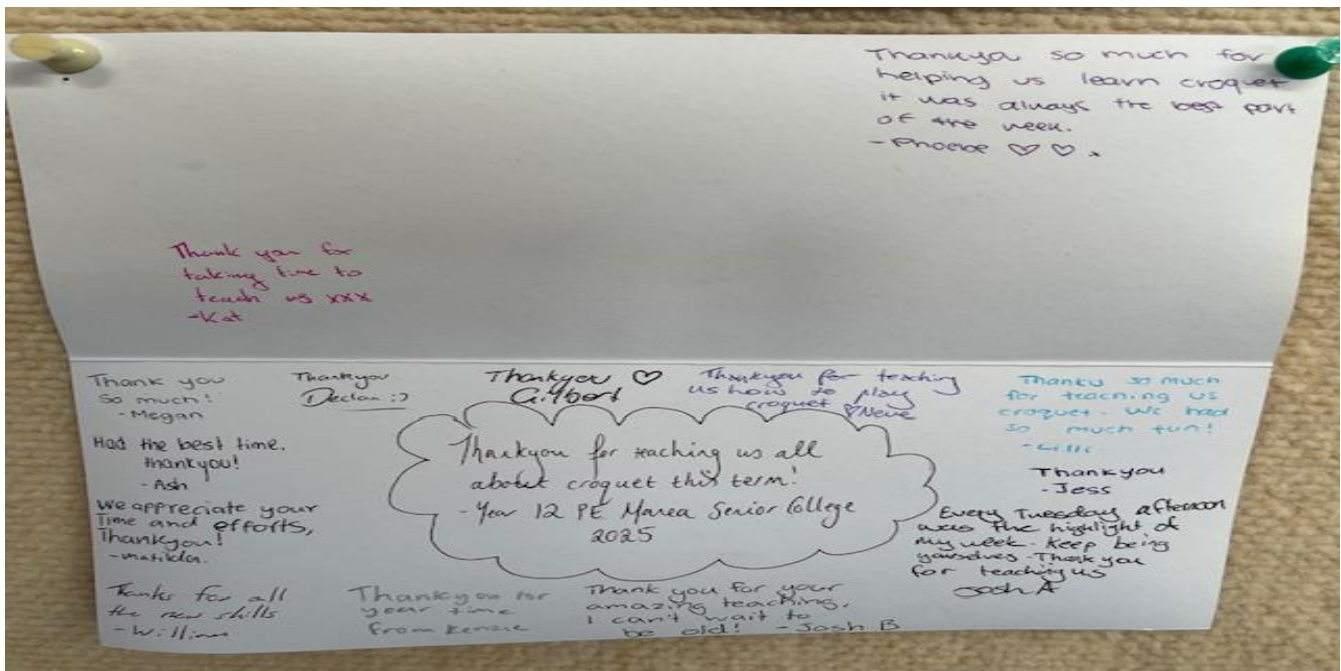
