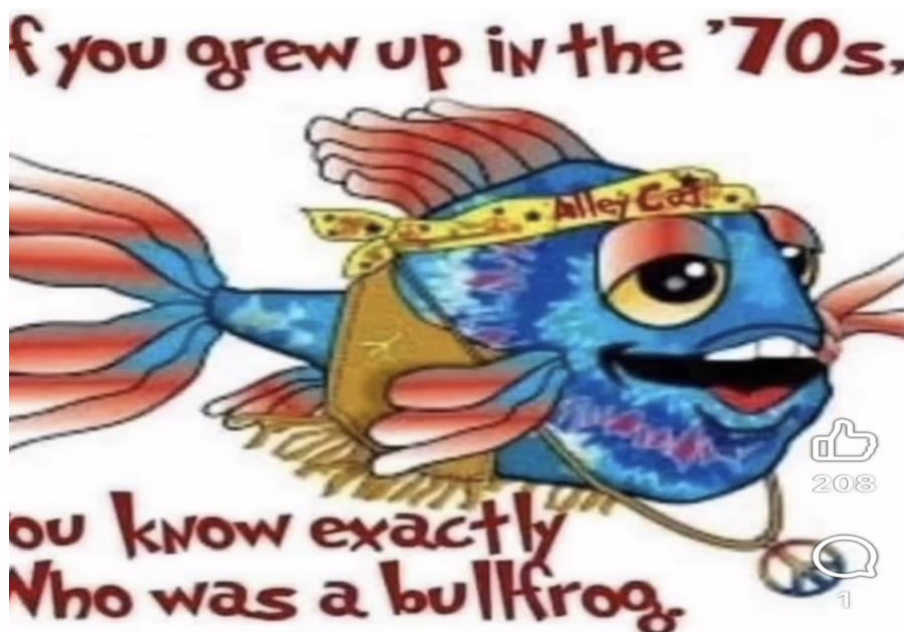
Croquetwest State GC Men's and Ladies Singles
