

# Jesus Is The Way

## John 14:6 (NKJV)

“Jesus said to him, *I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*”

Bible Besties... Jesus didn't say, “I *know* the way.”

He didn't say, “I'll *show* you the way.”

He said, “**I AM** the way.”

That means Christianity is not just a map- **it's a Person**. It's not merely a path, **it's a Savior**. And when the world gets loud and confusing, Jesus stands steady and simple: **Come to the Father through Me**.

## 1) THE WAY: Jesus Is Our Access

When Jesus says, “**I am the way,**” He's saying:

- You don't have to guess your way to God.
- You don't have to earn your way to God.
- You don't have to perform your way into God's love.

You don't approach the Father by perfect behavior; **you approach the Father by faith in Jesus**.

The Way is not a system... **The Way is a Shepherd**.

The Way is not a religious ladder... **The Way is the Cross**.

**John 14 is happening in a tender moment**. Jesus is preparing His disciples. Their hearts are troubled; His words are stabilizing them. He's basically saying:

“Don't panic. Don't spiral. Don't collapse in fear. **You have Me and I am your way home.**”

## 2) THE TRUTH: Jesus Is Our Foundation

Jesus is not just the way we walk; He's the truth we stand on.

Truth isn't whatever is trending.

Truth isn't whatever is convenient.

Truth isn't whatever feels good in the moment.

**Truth has a name.** His name is Jesus.

When the enemy whispers lies like:

- "You're too far gone."
- "God won't forgive you."
- "You'll never change."

**Jesus answers with Truth:**

- "I paid for you."
- "I chose you."
- "I can transform you."

## 3) THE LIFE: Jesus Is Our Source

Jesus is not only the entrance... He is the energy, the oxygen, the strength, the life *inside* the believer.

If you feel dry, tired, weary, or distracted, come back to the Source.  
Not just church attendance.

Not just Christian content.

**Come back to Christ.**

Because life isn't found in trying harder... **It's found in abiding closer.**

## Cross-Reference Scriptures (NKJV)

### 1) Acts 4:12 (NKJV)

“Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

➡ Salvation is not found in many names; **it’s found in Jesus alone!**  
**AMEN!!!**

### 2) 1 Timothy 2:5 (NKJV)

“For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,”

➡ A mediator brings both sides together: **Jesus is the Bridge.**

### 3) John 10:9 (NKJV)

“I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.”

➡ Jesus isn’t a locked gate: He is an open Door to rescue and rest.

## Holy Highlights

### 1. **Jesus doesn’t just point to God; He brings you to God.**

Your access is not based on your perfection, but His promise.

### 2. **The “Way” is secure even when life feels uncertain.**

When your emotions wobble, Jesus remains steady.

### 3. **The invitation is personal: “Come to the Father through Me.”**

God isn’t offering a cold religion; He’s offering a living relationship.

## Wisdom Nuggets

1. **Jesus is the Way, so you don't need a backup plan; you need deeper trust.**
2. **Truth isn't a vibe; Truth is a Savior. Stay close to Jesus, and you'll stay anchored.**
3. **The life you're craving won't be found in more noise, it's found in more Jesus.**
