

## 10 Powerful Truths About Exodus with Scripture

### 1. God hears the cries of His people

God was not ignoring Israel in their suffering. He heard them, remembered His covenant, and moved on their behalf.

#### **Exodus 2:24-25 (NKJV)**

*“So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged them.”*

### 2. God calls ordinary people for holy purposes

Moses did not feel qualified, but God still called him. This shows us that God uses willing hearts, even when they feel weak.

#### **Exodus 3:10 (NKJV)**

*“Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.”*

### 3. God’s presence makes the difference

When Moses was called, God did not promise ease, but He did promise His presence.

#### **Exodus 3:12 (NKJV)**

*“So He said, ‘I will certainly be with you.’”*

### 4. God is the great I AM

In Exodus, God reveals His holy name and shows that He is eternal, self-existing, and all-powerful.

#### **Exodus 3:14 (NKJV)**

*“And God said to Moses, ‘I AM WHO I AM.’ And He said, ‘Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”*

## **5. God delivers His people from bondage**

The book of Exodus is a powerful picture of deliverance. God brought Israel out of slavery with His mighty hand.

### **Exodus 6:6 (NKJV)**

*“Therefore say to the children of Israel: ‘I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.’”*

## **6. The blood of the lamb brings protection**

Passover points us to the power of redemption and protection through the blood. This is one of the most powerful themes in Exodus.

### **Exodus 12:13 (NKJV)**

*“Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you.”*

## **7. God makes a way where there seems to be no way**

At the Red Sea, Israel looked trapped, but God opened a path through the impossible.

### **Exodus 14:13-14 (NKJV)**

*“And Moses said to the people, ‘Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today... The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.’”*

## **8. God provides for His people day by day**

In the wilderness, God gave manna, water, and care. He was teaching His people to trust Him daily.

### **Exodus 16:12 (NKJV)**

*“At twilight you shall eat meat, and in the morning you shall be filled with bread. And you shall know that I am the Lord your God.”*

## **9. God calls His people to obedience and holiness**

Exodus teaches that redeemed people are called to live differently. God gave His commandments to guide His people in truth.

### **Exodus 20:3 (NKJV)**

*“You shall have no other gods before Me.”*

## **10. God desires to dwell among His people**

One of the most beautiful truths in Exodus is that God wanted His presence among His people.

### **Exodus 25:8 (NKJV)**

*“And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.”*
