The Caring Community Collaborative (C3) is a non-profit organization whose mission is to identify and respond to needs where service, education, and volunteerism benefit and strengthen our community.

Certainly, 2020 has been a challenging year for all of us. We're living in unprecedented times requiring rethinking perspectives and creating new outlooks. As an organization, C3 has rewritten our script as well. Not only have the needs in our community changed, but also the ways we address them. The C3 team went back to the drawing board to recreate how to continue to help our community with safe and purposeful programming.

- ❖ In the early days of the pandemic, we launched the "#1000ThankYou's" campaign, with banners and thank you notes delivered to health care, fire and police in our community to recognize their front-line work.
- ❖ We connected and supported the community through social media with wellness tips, family activities, community information, and front-line hero spotlights.
- ❖ We reinvented our annual Mental Health Conference in partnership with Lakota Schools by creating a 6-week *virtual* workshop series, open to the public and professionals at no cost. "The Impact of Social Media and Technology on Youth" brought training on topics like the downside of social media, safe technology use for kids, and teen suicide from keynote speakers who are renowned experts in their field.
- ❖ In partnership with the Butler County Emergency Management Agency, C3 delivered hand sanitizer stations throughout West Chester and Liberty townships to businesses, houses of worship, and community organizations.
- ❖ Our annual Veterans Event was held outdoors at Lakota West, allowing veterans and their families to remain in their vehicles while experiencing the ceremony through their car radio. The program featured the Lakota West Choir, Congressman Warren Davidson, and a World War II plane flyover.
- ❖ We wrapped up the year with the C3 Santa Shoebox Project. In recognition of the isolation many senior citizens have experienced throughout the pandemic, we delivered 179 gift boxes to seniors in our community, and 500 handmade cards from students.

We are looking toward a brighter 2021, putting new plans in place and setting high hopes that programming like Empty Bowls and Food with Friends will be able to resume in person. However, we will have plan B. With the inability to host in-person fundraising events in 2020, our funding has been nearly nonexistent. To continue bringing outreach, educational and service-oriented programming, we are asking community members and businesses to consider participating in our sponsorship or donation program.

We are asking for your support to continue our work. Thank you for your consideration in support of C3.
