2 hours twice per month

Virtual School-Based Program

1 hour per week

You'll provide encouragement and friendship to an elementary school student in a secure online environment. Includes fun group activities like "two truths and a lie," "would you rather," and "Simon says" facilitated by a Big Brothers Big Sisters coordinator.

Sports Buddies

2 hours, twice per month

Based on a shared interest in sports or fitness, you'll encourage and empower a youth while being active together, or by playing or watching the sports you both love. Will include post-pandemic group outings to sporting events, organized by a Big Brothers Big Sisters coordinator.
