# **ROOSEVELT CITY ORDINANCE** **PROHIBITS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** **IN SOFTBALL COMPLEXES.**

1. Tournament officials of the UBIC Board of Directors will not be liable of any injuries received by participants of spectators.
2. Games will be 55 minutes. No new inning after 50 minutes unless the game is tied.
3. Game time is forfeit time, (according to umpire's time).
4. All teams must turn in roster at check-in. **Roster is final after 2<sup>nd</sup> tournament game.**
5. Players must be 16 years of age or older to play. Players 16-18 years old must have a parent signature on the roster. Using a player too young will result in a forfeit for every game he/she has played.
6. A team can play with 8 players with 2 outs of 9 players with 1 out. Teams with 7 players will be considered a forfeit.
7. Lineups for each game must be turned in to the official scorekeeper at least 15 minutes prior to game time.

8. Teams must be ready to play at game time. The umpire may, at his/her discretion, forfeit the game for non-compliance.
9. The umpires before each game will establish rules for the game.
10. The home team will be decided by a coin toss at the beginning of each game.
11. **No Metal Cleats.**
12. No leading off.
13. No throwing bats. In the umpires judgment players may be ejected.
14. No children are to be in the dugouts or in the fenced playing field.
15. Runners will be called out if the runner attempts to take out the base player. Please slide to avoid injury.
16. 10 run rule after the 5<sup>th</sup> inning. 21 run after 3<sup>rd</sup> inning.
17. Any team personnel who conduct themselves in an unsportsmanlike manner subjects themselves and/or team to suspension, this includes spectators.
18. **No profanity will be permitted!**

19. It shall be the responsibility of the team captain to maintain contact with the tournament director in case of schedule disruption.
20. The team captain is responsible for seeing that the team's dugout is clean after completion of their team's game.
21. Two home runs over the opposing team, anything after is a **OUT**.
22. Team entry refunds will be made at the discretion of the tournament director.
23. In the event that play cannot continue, the method of establishing the order of finish will be determined by the tournament director and/or the umpires.
24. **All protests shall be \$100.00 up front!**
25. The tournament director has the right to amend these rules as needed.
26. A banned bat list will be available at check-in.
27. 4 balls will be provided at check-in. If your team runs out of balls it will be \$5.00 an ball.
