# **PGCEA Elects New Officers in Successful Online Voting**

The Provincial Government of Cavite Employees Association (PGCEA), the official organization representing the employees of the Provincial Government of Cavite, successfully conducted its election of officers for the 2025-2026 term on March 14, 2025.
