

## Cavite moves to combat COVID-19



TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite, Mar 24 (PIA) -- Cavite province joined several local governments across Luzon to declare state of calamity due to the increasing cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic.

President Rodrigo Duterte's initial proclamation placing Metro Manila under general community quarantine prompted the Provincial Board of Cavite to pass Resolution No. 1437-2020 on March 16, declaring the province under state of calamity. With the declaration, Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla

## LGU Imus addresses transport, financial dilemma under ECQ

IMUS CITY, Cavite, Mar. 24 (PIA) -- Imus City Mayor Emmanuel Maliksi together with officials of concerned offices outlined a program for transportation, food, health and other concerns to address issues that cropped up in the implementation of enhanced community quarantine (ECQ) in the city.

Different problems arose from the implementation of the ECQ, particularly with the suspension of mass transportation and the lockdown of the cities and municipalities with hundreds of commuters returning home from work or going to work in the south were stranded.

The threat of the COVID-19 contagion did

not deter the people from leaving their homes because the ordinary workers were more concerned with their livelihood rather than their safety and continued to go out to report for work.

will enable to access its quick response funds amounting to P20 million for interventions and measures to prevent COVID-19 from spreading in the different parts of the province, according to the Provincial Information and

Community Affairs Department (PICAD)

Remulla also issued an executive order placing the whole province under community quarantine to further prevent the spread of the deadly disease.

Effective March 17, curfew hours have been imposed in the province from 8pm to 5am for non-essential personnel on the streets while malls, computer shops, spas, gaming parlors, even tiangges, basketball courts, public

parks and playgrounds, and resorts were ordered to close temporarily.

Only restaurants (no dine-in only take-outs and deliveries), banks, public utility offices, payment centers and other related financial services, groceries, supermarkets, pharmacies, pawnshops, hardwares, and

checkpoints manned by uniformed personnel and quarantine officers to monitor the movement of people limited to accessing basic needs.

**COVID-19 claims 1st fatality in Cavite; confirmed cases rise to 14**

### TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite, Mar. 24 (PIA)

-- In a COVID-19 update report of Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla, a 76-year old resident of Bacoor died on Friday, March 19, 2020 from the Corona Virus Disease, the first fatality of COVID-19 in Cavite.

Governor Remulla reminded the elderly and senior citizens particularly those with health issues to be extra careful.

"Senior citizens are at risk. Please don't go out and bring the virus home with you," Gov. Remulla reiterated.

As of 1 PM of March 23, the Provincial Health Office (PHO) COVID-19 Case Tracker-Cavite listed that the total of number of confirmed cases in the whole province of Cavite is now 14.

In addition, the cumulative number of patients under investigation (PUIs) since January 23 is 265 while persons under monitoring (PUMs) is 4,883.

The PHO is calling on Cavite residents to stay home, "Huwag tayong maging sanhi ng pagkalat ng COVID-19."
