Hospital in Naic, Cavite victimized by food delivery pranks



NAIC, Cavite – Personnel of Naic Doctors Hospital (NDH) were pranked by an unknown culprit who almost had P16,000 worth of food delivered to the medical facility.

On Saturday (October 9), the hospital posted an announcement asking nearby businesses to call their official contact number first before sending any food orders.

According to the post, the prankster ordered 38

Missing Cavite boatmen rescued after 5 days

CAVITE CITY, Cavite: After five days of relentless search for the motorized boat reported missing in Ternate, Cavite, the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) Search and Rescue Operation found the incapacitated vessel and rescued three people onboard near Capones Island in San Antonio, Zambales. The PCG identified the rescued boatmen as Joey Lescano, 38; Jessabel Semella, 29; and Jhon Larence Reyes, 16, who are all residents of Barangay 7 in Cavite City. "They were all successfully rescued and in good condition and were rendered necessary assistance by PCG in San Antonio, Zambales," said PCG-Cavite station Cdr. Michael Encina. According to the rescued boatmen, the motorbanca Adonis departed San Rafael in Noveleta, Cavite on October 3 to transport their relatives to Mariveles, Bataan. However, upon their return trip to Cavite, they encountered engine trouble near Ternate.

Unable to steer the boat, they stayed afloat for five days amid strong winds and high waves caused by tropical depression "Lannie" until the PCG spotted them five nautical miles west of Capones Island.

Coast guard leads mangrove planting in Cavite

NOVELETA, Cavite: The Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) celebrated its 120th founding anniversary with a mangrove planting initiative at the mangrove protected area in Barangay San Rafael 4 on October 10, Sunday, with the local Environment and Natural Resources office here. A total of 2,500 seedlings and mangrove propagules were planted in the area for two days with the River Ranger Noveleta, Marine Environmental Protection Command, PCG Cavite and the Municipal Environment Regional Office (Menro) of Noveleta. "We are grateful to the PCG's continued support for the environment of the town of Noveleta, not only in marine disasters, but also in environmental protection," Noveleta Mayor Dino Chua said in an interview. PCG-Cavite commander Lt. Michael Encina and Noveleta Menro chief Edgardo Chavez led the mangrove planting with their staff and volunteers.

U.S. Military and Philippine Coast Guard Conduct Tactical Combat Casualty Care Training

From October 4 to 6, members of the U.S. Civilian Military Support Element-Philippines (CMSE PHL) conducted Tactical Combat Casualty Care Training with the Philippine Coast Guard North Eastern Luzon District (PCGNELZ). This is the first time the U.S. military has been able to train directly with the PCGNELZ.

The training strengthened the medical capabilities of the participants who work in a wide range of environments during maritime and land-based operations. The course consisted of Basic Life

1st District Representative Francis Gerald "Boy Blue" Abaya, for mayor of Kawit against his second cousin, reelectionist Angelo Aguinaldo. 2nd District Representative Strike Revilla, for mayor of Bacoor, which compromises the entire district. He used to be mayor of the city.

3rd District Representative Alex "AA" Advincula, for mayor of Imus, which compromises the entire district. He used to be top councilor of the city.

5th District Representative Dahlia Loyola, for mayor of Carmona. She used to be mayor of the municipality.

6th District Representative Luis "Jon Jon" Ferrer IV, for mayor of General Trias, which compromises the entire district. 8th District Representative Abraham "Bambol" Tolentino, for mayor of Tagaytay. He used to be mayor of the city. Meanwhile, four congressional candidates are running unopposed: Imus Councilor Adrian Jay Advincula, for 3rd District congressman, seeking to swap posts with his father (see list above). Carmona Mayor Roy Loyola, for 5th District congressman, seeking to swap posts with his wife (see list above). He used to be the dis-

trict's representative.

General Trias City Mayor Antonio Ferrer, for 6th District congressman, seeking to swap posts with his brother (see list above).

Reelectionist 7th District Representative Jesus Crispin "Boying" Remulla.

Four veteran politicians running for district representative are being challenged by independents:

Bacoor City Mayor Lani Revilla, seeking the 1st District seat versus Jose Herminio Japson. Revilla, who used to be congresswoman, seeks to swap posts again with her brother in law (see earlier list). Reelectionist 4th Dis-

trict Representative Elpidio Barzaga, being challenged by Osmundo Catupad.

Tagaytay City Mayor Agnes Tolentino has a challenger in Allan Par in the 8th District. She seeks to swap posts with her husband (see earlier list)

So far, a heated race is expected in the 1st District, where Paul Abaya, younger brother of outgoing congressman Boy Blue, will go head-to-head with outgoing Vice Governor Jolo Revilla.

Cavite has 7 cities and 16 municipalities, grouped into 8 congressional districts. It had 2,148,899 registered voters in 2019.

Carmona's 1st Tourism Summit awards local businesses

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — The Municipal Government of Carmona through its Municipal Information, Tourism, Culture and Arts Office (MITCAO) held the 1st Tourism Summit on Monday, September 27, 2021 in celebration of World Tourism Day.

The summit themed "Tourism for Inclusive Growth" recognized two local business establishments among 432 participants from tourism enterprises, government agencies, universities and, other organizations.

The recipients of the 1st Outstanding Tourism Enterprise Award are Wing Crib Chicken Corner, and the Manila Jockey Club, Inc., which both shown concern for employees' welfare and the community during the pandemic.

Wing Crib Chicken Corner proprietor-owner Mr. Edward Joseph Silva said that it has been a very challenging year for him and his business established in 2020 during the height of the pandemic.

Silva said that formation of manpower schedule was the first major challenge due to the quarantine restrictions that gave limit to the movement of the people.

Skeleton manpower had to be followed to keep the personnel and the clientele safe, and for operations to continue

despite the erratic conditions brought by the protocols implemented.

The staff were given hazard pay to somehow incentivize their efforts. They also took part in the distribution of relief goods to 100 residents in the barangay as a way of giving back to the community.

Silva said, "Let's be strong, let's not give up... whether rich or poor, everyone is affected by this pandemic. If we try to engage in business, let's take a risk, let's not think about what others say. And above all, let us trust in the Lord."

The Manila Jockey Club, Inc. (MJCI) is the most beautiful race track in Asia which was founded in 1867, and started as a social club in Manila.

San Lazaro Leisure Park Head, Dr. Ron Laymera says the racetrack has since moved from one place to another, until it settled on its current location in April 2003.

Through the years the property diversified. Aside from the racetrack, a subdivision was developed along with a football field among others, shared MJCI Food & Beverage head Cecille Villanueva.

Villanueva said that they came up with sharing with about 150 families from the staff and employees of the company greatly affected with the temporary closing of business due to lockdowns and quarantine restrictions.

Horse owners and other business partners donated to help the families and they regularly gave rice, groceries and other relief packs during the pandemic.

The company also has a Health & Safety Committee which helps minimize the CoViD cases among the employees and their families.

"Tourism is a connective network, once tourists and visitors come in, businesses will thrive. total of P16,000. Fortunately, the restaurants called the hospital first before sending the food. This is not the first time that NDH has been a target of food delivery

pranks. In March, a culprit placed a cash-on-delivery order of pizzas and burgers to the hospital. On-duty doctors had to chip in to pay for the food delivery.

Noveleta Mayor inaugurates LGU priority projects

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — Noveleta town Mayor Dino Reyes-Chua celebrated his birthday with the inauguration of several priority projects on Tuesday, September 28, 2021.

Mayor Chua, together with MAYNILAD official Norman Kahulugan, Tubig Pag-asa Program Manager Maridette Tabuco, and Sitio Aplaya Residents Association President Belinda Sacapano led the ceremonial water drinking and formal water gate bulb opening of the Tubig Pag-asa water system.

The 'patubig' or water system will supply around 302 families in Sitio Aplaya, Barangay San Rafael III.

"Lahat po tayo ay nagsisimula sa malinis na tubig, hindi na po mahihirapan ang ating mga kababayan dito sa Sitio Aplaya para sa malinis na tubig na maiinum, na dati ay hinahakot pa natin mula sa labasan," Mayor Dino Chua said.

(We all start with clean water, the families here in Sitio Aplaya will no longer have difficulty to access clean drinking water fetched from outside the area.)

Dino Chua also led the turnover of Noveleta College of Technology, a new ambulance for the 'Doc to Door' program of the Noveleta Health Office,

He also led the inauguration of several facilities including the new Fire Station Building in the municipal grounds, San Jose Fitness Gym, new E-Library located in Brgy. San Jose 2, the new wing of the Noveleta MedCare Hospital, and the street lights along the stretch of Barangay San Rafael III and IV.

He also led the ground breaking ceremonies for the construction of the Noveleta Crematorium and Columbarium; Cavite State University (CvSU) Noveleta Campus in TIP compound and the Unlad Noveleta Gymnasium in Brgy San

Noveleta medical facility improved with add'l rooms, ambulances

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — Noveleta town Mayor Dino Reyes-Chua and Municipal Health Officer Dr. Maria Hilda Bucu lead the turnover of two new ambulances and the inauguration of the additional medical rooms of the Noveleta MedCare Hospital in Barangay San Jose 1 on September 28.

The two new L300 FB type ambulances are dedi-

cated for the 'Doc to Doors' program of the Municipal Health Office while six (6) new hospital rooms for an additional 12 bed capacity for the medical facility, equipped with air conditioner, LCD TV, comfort rooms, oxygen tanks, and nurses' station gave the medical hospital an upgrade.

Mayor Chua said that the new ambulances and the additional rooms will aug-

ment the present medical capacity of the hospital to help more indigents infected with COVID-19.

Mayor Chua said during the event that there are plans to open a Dialysis center on the third floor of the building to expand the medical services of the facility.

He also thanked the management of PNB and Asia Brewery for providing 600 doses of AstraZeneca vaccines which will be used for the LGU's vaccination program. Mayor Chua announced that registration for the inoculation of children aged 12 to 17 years in the locality is now open in preparation for the go-signal for their vaccination.

Currently, the vaccination efforts of the LGU has fully vaccinated 48% of the 70% target population belonging to the A1, A1.8, A1.9, A2, A3, A4, and A5 while 72% have received the 1st dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. —Ruel Francisco, PIA Cavite (with reports from Bagong Noveleta/Dennis Abrina)



Cavite town amends regulations on business operations

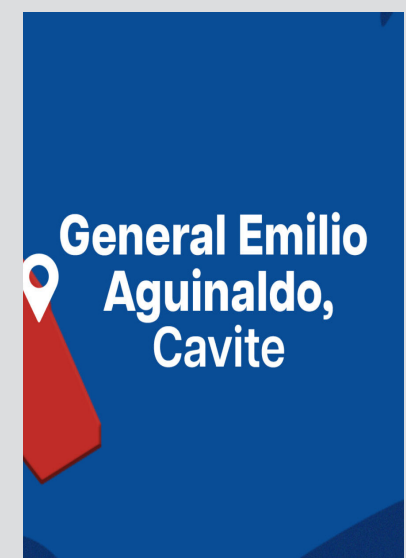
TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — The local government of General Emilio Aguinaldo-Bailen issued Executive Order no. 37 S. 2021, amending certain provisions of E.O. no. 36 S. 2021 with provisions on opening of business establishments on Sundays among others.

The policy developed in consultation with the members of the Association of Barangay Captains in the municipality which would help owner-proprietors of establishments recover from their losses during the lockdown.

The order allows for the opening of to personal care service establishments such as barber shops, salons, and nail spas up to 20% of capacity provided that wearing of face masks by the staff/crew as well as the clientele be observed at all times.

This also includes the provision of alcohol, and the regular conduct of disinfection of all tools and equipment used.

All establishments in the town are now allowed to operate on Sundays until



the curfew hours starting at 8PM. The order also declares the removal of barricades in Barangay Poblacion allowing the use of the road as an alternative route thereby decongesting the volume of vehicles especially in the town proper. — Ruel Francisco, PIA Cavite (with reports from LGU Aguinaldo-Bailen)
