Cavite-Bataan Bridge Project Moves Forward as 8 Firms Bid on First Phase

The race to build the foundation of the nation's most ambitious bridge project is now on, with eight major construction giants submitting financial bids for the first segment of the Bataan-Cavite Interlink Bridge.

In a public bid opening live-streamed on social media last September 30, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) unveiled the contenders for Contract Package 1. This high-stakes competition underscores the scale of an infrastructure project poised to transform

"This bidding is a testament to our commitment to transparency," a DPWH official stated, following President Ferdinand Marcos Ir.'s directive for open and accountable governance in all flagship projects.

The eight groups vying for the multi-billion peso contract are a mix of international and local heavyweights:

- Beijing Urban Construction Group Co. Ltd.
- D.M. Consunji Inc. China Harbour
- Engineering Company Ltd. · Sino Road and
- Bridge Group Co. Ltd. EEI – PMI Joint
- Venture POSCO E&C – Sta.

- China Wu Yi Co. public Ltd. / Fujian Road & Bridge Construction Group Co. Ltd. (Consortium)
 - Hunan Road Bridge Construction Group Ltd. and China Civil Engineering Construction Corporation Joint Venture

This initial phase, with an approved agency estimate of PHP 7.25 billion, focuses on constructing the "Bataan Land Approach." This includes a network of interchanges and viaducts that will form the critical connection from the bridge to the road network in Bataan.

For Cavite residents, the progress on the Bataan side signals that the entire 32.15-kilometer project is advancing from blueprint

to reality. Once complete, the Bataan-Cavite Interlink Bridge will be the longest water-spanning bridge in the Philippines, turning what is currently a lengthy

journey into a direct and convenient link, unlocking neweconomicopportunities for the province. (Source: Philippine News Agency)
