TIME COMMITMENT

- Rehearsals:
 - Saturdays 11:00 AM - 1:30 PM, based generally on every other week format: August 29, September 12 & 26, October 3 & 24, November 7 & 21, December 5* (*Friday evening)
 - Two Friday evening rehearsals for advanced groups: August 28 and September 25
- Tentative Show Dates: December 12-13 at Brewer High School
- Tentative Dress Rehearsal: December 12 (morning)
- Tentative Nutcracker Tea Party: December 6 (Lead roles are expected to attend)
- Only ONE known absence is allowed in order to participate in The Nutcracker.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

Participation Fees contribute to the cost of the production, including venue, teachers, rehearsals, and administration. Costume fees will be charged on August 25 and participation fees on September 15.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will each dancer always rehearse at the same time?

While Saturday rehearsals will always fall between 11:00 - 1:30, we can't guarantee that your dancer will always rehearse at the exact same time each week. Please reserve 11:00 - 1:30 on your calendar for all of our rehearsal dates! In the past, we've provided the first 2 months of rehearsal schedule by August 1 and the remaining schedules by October 1. Most rehearsals are in 45 minute time blocks (i.e. 11:00 - 11:45). Dancers cast in multiple roles will have multiple rehearsals each rehearsal weekend.

How many parts will my dancer have?

Dancers are cast based on the total number of available parts, as well as each dancer's age and technical level. Other considerations are rehearsal scheduling and the lengths of each piece included in the production, some as long as seven minutes!

We want to make participation as accessible as possible and acknowledge every family has differing scheduling and financial capacity. To that end, you may opt for your dancer to be considered for only one role. All casting is determined by faculty choreographers and a dancer's number of roles may change year to year.

Are there any costs outside of costume and participation fees?

Commemorative cast t-shirts are optional. Three total performance tickets are included in each dancer's participation fee. All other performance tickets are \$20. Each dancer will need clean ballet shoes for performances.
